

QUEEN OF HEARTS – RULES OF THE GAME

1. A game board containing 54 cards purchased from a certified gaming vendor will be displayed in the social quarters, with the QUEEN OF HEARTS as the “JACKPOT CARD”
2. Card carrying current members of the American Legion, Sons of the American Legion or Auxiliary in good standing are eligible to play. If you do not have your membership card with you, you cannot buy tickets or win any of the money prizes.
3. \$1.00 per chance, with no limit on the amount of tickets that can be purchased. NO group tickets, one name per ticket.
4. Sign your name on the back of the ticket and return it to the bartender. Do not sign nicknames, abbreviations, or numbers. Exception; if a member wishes to donate their winnings, any reference to Post 177 will be acceptable. (i.e. Post 177, SAL 177, ALA 177, etc)
5. Every Saturday at 7:30 PM, a name will be drawn from the tickets purchased that week. If you show up at 7:31 PM, you will be considered not present, and you will win half of the money if your name is drawn. The clubroom clock is the official clock.
6. If your name is drawn, you choose a card. If the card drawn is the “Queen of Hearts”, the winner will receive 60% of the Jackpot. If you are not present and your name is drawn, the winner will only receive 30% of the Jackpot. (The remaining 30% will go back in the drawing pot for the next game), 10% to National American Legion
7. If the Joker is drawn you will win \$200, if a FACE CARD or the ACE is drawn you will win \$50. All other cards are \$5.00. If you are not present for the drawing then you will receive half the money as designated by the card, the remaining will go toward the next game.
8. Once a card is selected, that card will be removed from play.
9. Each week after the drawing, all tickets will be destroyed.
10. All players are responsible for any and all taxes. You will be issued a W2-G on prizes over \$600. NO prize over \$600 will paid until the W2-G information is completely filled out. If a player is unwilling to do a W2-G, then the prize will revert back to the club.
