This may confuse new members thinking, "Jeez, I just joined in February and I'm being asked to renew in July?". All American Legion memberships expire December 31 of the year on the card. The Legion collects next year's membership dues starting in July of the previous year. (This also means that current year membership goals must be met by July. We missed our 100% goal by 7 members). So, if you first join the Legion in the first half of a year, you get a little less time for your dues and if you join in the second half of the year you get a little more time for your dues. But after the first year it evens out.

Membership is the currency of influence for our organization when we are advocating for our causes in Washington and Richmond. I encourage you to renew your membership for 2018 as soon as you are able. National Guard and Reserve Members VA Benefits

Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Program supports and enhances the mobilization readiness of the Reserve components. The AGR includes both National Guard (Title 32) and Reserve members (Title 10) who serve full-time. National Guard members may establish eligibility for certain VA benefits by performing full-time duty under either Title 32 or Title 10.

Generally, all National Guard and Reserve member discharged or released under conditions that are not dishonorable are eligible for some VA benefits. Come to the seminar and find out what constitutes qualifying service for the National Guard and Reserve.

This seminar will also include a discussion of the most up to date information on available VA home loan program benefits. It will include info on the increase in maximum loan limits in high cost areas such as Fairfax and Arlington counties. Additionally, it will cover options for disabled service members, Veterans and their spouses along with grants available for disabled veterans. All are welcome! 

Keeping you up to date on Corporate Board (CB) activities the following is provided: Elections were held in May, Russ Combs and John Kinczel were elected to the board for three (3) year terms. In addition, at the May meeting Officers were elected for the CB and appointments made. Jonathan Thacher (President), Gary Welschenbach (Secretary), Anthony "Tony" Osborne (Treasurer), Rand Gaber (Building & Grounds), Mike Kimlick, Russ Combs, John Kinczel and Jeff White Post 177 Commander

The CB continues to diligently watch over The Post's financial asset structure in savings, checking, CD's, building infrastructure/maintenance, furniture, equipment, exterior structures and grounds. We are presently, as has been the case in the past and the goal of the future in an excellent financial position.

The first meeting of the Building Initiatives committee was held on 2 June. As stated in the last newsletter this is just the beginning of a multiyear process to lead the Vision of Post 177 in the Year 2047. The committee is looking at sustaining and/or remodeling the present Post; or is there a need for a new facility. The committee is looking at Maintenance cost today and in the next five years by developing a 5 -10 year plan. It is felt there are in some ways many sustaining costs and factors that will need inclusion into remodeling. This is a labor intensive task that must be done to then get an accurate risk analysis. Again as to why it will be a multiyear scenario to reach an answer. There is one primary assumption: Our revenue stream must remain continuous and we must look at ways to increase it so that there is minimal to no cost to the POST and revenue still maintains the operations of the Post to our best standards.

The CB is trying to stay on a cycle of meeting the third (3rd) Wednesday of each month at 6 PM at the Post.
