MESSAGE FROM THE COMMANDER

Hard to believe it is October already. The pandemic has changed the way we do things not just at the post, but throughout society. Schools opened in a virtual only way in September but they are going to start some phased in person learning soon. That means there will be buses and kids walking along streets and inexperienced drivers on the roads. And the days are getting shorter. Please be alert when driving and keep an eye out for the children.

Though the pandemic has caused us to cancel some things, we are finding new ways to celebrate important events. On Independence Day we used our trailer in the City of Fairfax Independence Day Wave Parade. A wave parade is a procession of vehicles driving through the neighborhoods of the city for the residents to come out and wave as it goes by. It lasted about 3 hours. Because of limitations on the number of vehicles allowed in the parade VFW Post 8469 joined us in manning the trailer and we had a joint AL and VFW banner on display.

We used the trailer again on Labor Day for the Clifton Lions Labor Day Car Show Wave Parade. For this one we had a Color Guard at the front of the trailer and several members of the Lions riding and tossing out little foam cars as we went through the neighborhoods.

We have not been doing second Sunday breakfasts because it is just not feasible to maintain social distancing for that event. For that same reason we will not have an Early Bird dinner. However, we have come up with a way to reward members for renewing early. Every Legionnaire, Auxiliary Member, and SAL Member who renews by 31 December 2020 will receive a coupon for one Friday Night Dinner. The coupon is non-transferable and must be redeemed by 30 July 2021.

On 7 November we will conduct our Veterans Day observance and Flag retirement ceremony. This will be outside and face coverings/masks required as they are for all activity at the Post now.

Wear your mask, wash your hands, be kind to one another. We will get through this.

CORPORATE BOARD NEWS

First and foremost, we hope that you and your family and friends are safe and healthy in this trying time, as work on many things that must continue to sustain the American Legion and it's mission.

- 1. The Development Project for the new post home is in the city zoning process.
 - a. We received the first set of comments back from the City of Fairfax staff on September 17 and have had several zoom meetings since working the replies.
 - b. As previously stated, this project plans for a total replacement/modernization of Chilcott Little League field and we are working towards a final design.
 - c. We continue to work with the Korean radio station on replacing the existing antenna field with a single monopole antenna pole near the left field wall of the ball-field.
 - d. The public zoom meetings held back in June went well and we will soon be scheduling more in the upcoming months to keep the community informed.
- 2. Buckman Rd. Property-As previously stated our post has owned a piece of land on the route 1 corridor near Ft. Belvoir for years. We now signed a lease agreement that will include an option to buy the property.
- 3. The Corporate Board continues moving forward to establish a long term (30 years+) financial management plan to support the new post home and our mission. Our efforts in the months ahead will be to interview various financial institutions and establish a financial strategy for investment of funds.
- 4. Financial performance this year is on target for revenue and expenses.
- 5. Legion year 2020-2021 Corporate Board budget was finalized and passed by GM meeting in August. Key line items include fiscal support for Social Quarters as we rebound from the COVID-19, increase in post cleaning services to protect members and guests, support of the development project, increased monies to the post for donations along with our normal expenditures for the upkeep of the post.
- 6. The tentative schedule for the next three months meetings of the CB are Wednesdays 18 November, 16 December and 20 January 2021.

ALL MEETINGS WILL BE ZOOM MEETINGS and will begin at 7PM. Please be safe, wear a face mask and please respect social distancing.




